

Infant Community – Class 8 Daily Schedule

<u>Arrival (8:00-8:15)</u> The tone set for the start of the day is very important. Your infant will be greeted each morning as you enter the classroom. Please set aside a few minutes to share with us how the evening and morning progressed and fill out our daily sheet.

Morning and Afternoon Work Cycles (Arrival to Dismissal) All throughout your infants waking hours they can choose work from all areas of the prepared environment. This includes feeding, diapering, tummy time, crawling/walking, story time, napping, singing, and outdoor, exploration and sensorial exploration.

Their day is filled with language in both English and Spanish.

Outdoor Exploration We go outside every day, weather permitting. Dressing appropriately for the day's weather condition and dressing safely for exploration.

<u>Feeding</u> All infants are fed according to their developmental needs. Young infants are held in arms and older infants, who can sit independently, are invited to sit at a child sized table.

<u>Diapering</u> All infants are changed, and hands washed, as needed throughout the day. Young infants are changed on a diaper changing table while older infants are invited to stand up for diapering.

<u>Dismissal (3:00-3:15)</u> Please set aside a few minutes at the end of the each day to review your infant's daily sheet and to talk with the teachers. We love to share their day with you.
